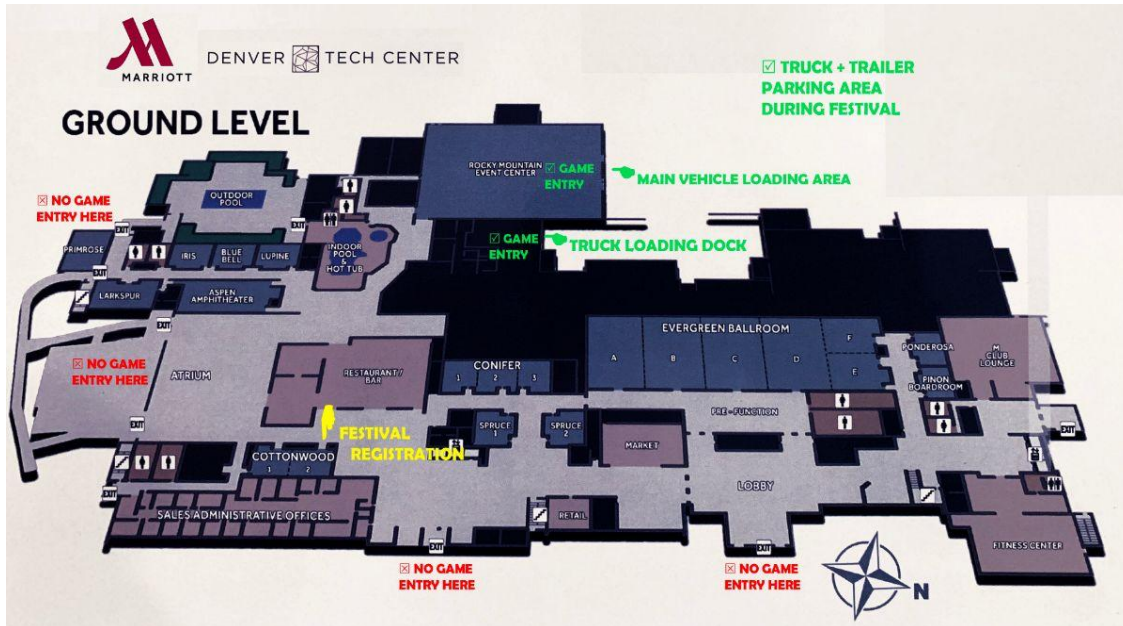
How to check in at the festival: Load-in

There are lots of great folks -- individuals and companies -- bringing games, and we want to make the load-in and out as easy as possible for everyone.

1. **PARK TEMPORARILY** -- When you initially get to the hotel, you can temporarily park your vehicle in the parking lot on the northwest side of the hotel. Please don't park in the main loading area or truck dock on the northwest side of the hotel *until* you have your game space assignment. You'll need to first know where your space and power are located, and then you can unload.
2. **REGISTER INSIDE** -- Please head to the registration desk at the front of the hotel in the *Cottonwood Room* and find Dan, Holly, or Valerie to check in. You will receive your packet of information, including incentives, and your exhibitor location, extra game spaces, and power assignment.

3. **UNLOAD MATERIALS AND GAMES** -- Unload your games as quickly and safely as possible. Stage them off to the inside of the festival hotel space.
 - Do NOT leave your vehicle unattended.
 - Do NOT bring games through the east, front doors of the hotel (aka, the lobby or the secondary entrances). The *main loading area and truck docks* are the only options available to us.
 - Do NOT set up games on the loading docks.
4. **MOVE YOUR VEHICLE** -- Everyone wants to be unloaded. Thank you for moving your vehicle so the next load of games may be unloaded quickly.
5. **PARKING DURING FESTIVAL** -- Please park any trucks, trailers, or haulers staying the duration of the festival on the northwest section of the Denver Marriott Tech Center property well away from the loading dock area.
6. **BOOTH AND GAME SET-UP** -- Be sure you are drawing from the correct power supply. If you are unsure, please ask. If you need additional chairs or tables, please let us know. All of your tables should have tablecloths as provided by the hotel. Thank you for helping a fellow gamer with set up if you have a free hand.
7. **PATIENCE** -- Thank you for your patience as folks figure out the flow of the new festival space.

Included per paid booth are 2 non-transferable, three-day, all-access

- 6'x2.5' tables with cloths, no charge
- Chairs, no charge
- Electricity, no charge for 20 amps/booth: *let us know if you need no electricity or more electricity.*



Festival close and load-out

- 1. GAME TEAR DOWN** -- The festival closes to the public at 5 pm Monday.
 - For safety reasons, do NOT begin tearing down any machines on the free-play floor until 5 pm Monday. Games leaving your exhibitor booth is allowed; but please supervise the games exit and make sure the game leaves through the proper doors (not the lobby!).
 - Thank you for helping a fellow gamer with tear down if you have a free hand.
- 2. STAGE MATERIAL AND GAMES TO LOAD** -- Stage booth materials and games off to the inside of the festival hotel space. Please do not block the exits or the loading docks.
- 3. LOAD GAMES** -- Load your booth materials and games as quickly and safely as possible.
 - Do NOT leave your vehicle unattended.
 - Do NOT bring games through the east, front doors of the hotel (aka, the lobby or the secondary entrances). The *main loading area and truck docks* are the only options available to us.
 - Do NOT team down games on the loading docks.
- 4. MOVE YOUR VEHICLE** -- Everyone wants to be loaded. Thank you for moving your vehicle so the next load of games may be loaded quickly.

2. Pinball machines, displays, and goods located inside exhibitor booths must be easily and safely accessible to showdown participants from the public aisles.
3. Set up is 9 am - 9 pm on Friday and from 8 am - 11 am Saturday. All games presented for use during the Rocky Mountain Pinball Showdown and Gameroom Expo on main show floor must be in playable condition and set to free play for the duration of the festival.
4. All electrical extension cords, tool boxes, and personal items must be secured so as to not pose a threat to the public, or public space and walkways. The festival is not responsible for stolen or broken items.
5. Denver Marriott DTC charges a fee to each exhibitor to hang its banners at a high level. Exhibitors may hang its own banner at a reasonable height using wall-safe/damage free hanging devices. Exhibitors must leave no holes, marks, or stains of any kind or pay damages to the hotel.
6. By purchasing booth space at the Rocky Mtn Pinball Showdown, the exhibitor and all exhibitor guests, employees, and associates agrees to all conditions, rules, and regulations set forth by Rocky Mtn Pinball Showdown LLC, Denver Marriott Tech Center, the state of Colorado, and all regulating authorities.

 20. No animals are allowed at the Rocky Mountain Pinball Showdown event per regulation of the hotel.

All pinball and video game machines on the free-play floor, **INCLUDING THOSE FOR SALE**, must remain in service and not be transported off the floor until 5 pm Monday, Exhibitors will inform buyers that machines purchased are not to be transported off of premises before 5 pm Monday. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Note: Games and merchandise sold from inside your booth may be moved at any time. Please supervise the movement of any large machines from your booth to the proper exit doors (not the lobby!).
